The general theme is **Ethical Perspectives Following Luce Irigaray** including sessions on philosophy, spirituality, politics and art.

Professor Luce Irigaray will give a talk 'The Ethical Responsibility of Thought Today' on the 18<sup>th</sup> June at 17.00 followed by a book signing, drinks reception and the gala dinner.

**THE LECTURE IS FREE FOR STAFF AND STUDENTS OF WARWICK BUSINESS SCHOOL AND WARWICK UNIVERSITY**

The conference will take place at the Warwick Business School, **M2 University of Warwick Campus.**

The **registration** includes all meals (including gala dinner) and will be £120 for the 2-day conference for staff and £60 for students and unwaged.

**The programme will be available by the end of May 2014.**

**The deadline for attending the conference ONLY (without accommodation) is 13<sup>th</sup> June:**

- 2 day conference 18-19<sup>th</sup> June (including a 3-course gala dinner with drinks) = £120 for staff and £60 for students and unwaged
- 1 day conference on the 18<sup>th</sup> June (including a 3-course gala dinner with drinks) = £80 for staff and £40 for students and unwaged
- 1 day conference on the 18<sup>th</sup> June (without the gala dinner) = £30 for all.
