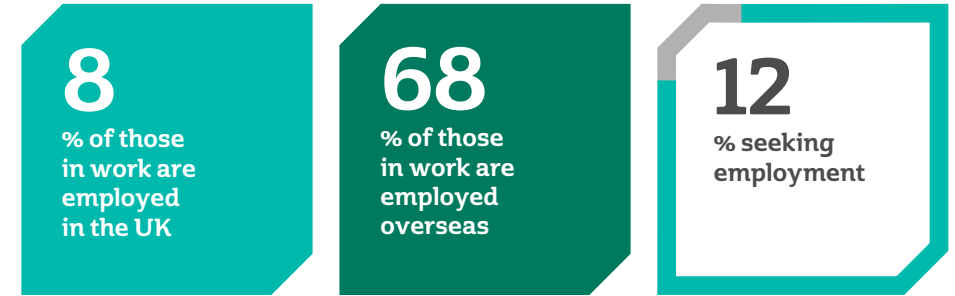
Note: The current survey was conducted six months after graduation and focuses on the employment and further study patterns of the graduates of the 2016 – 2017 class. A total of 54 of a possible 60 graduates were surveyed, and an aggregate response rate of 90% was achieved.

The MSc Management of Information Systems & Digital Innovation course was previously known as MSc Information Systems Management & Innovation, with the title changing for 2017 entry. The course content was unchanged.

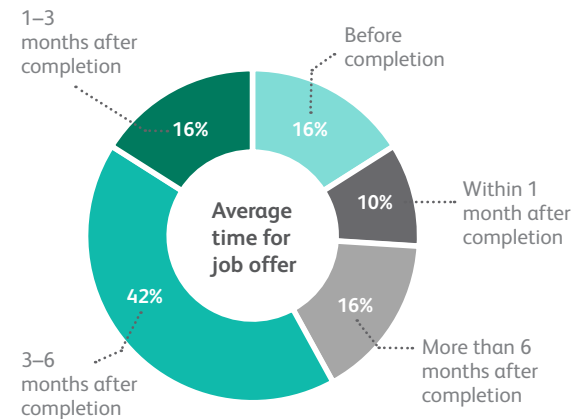
How long does it take to get a job?

76% of graduates are in full time employment six months after graduation, 2% are in further study.



*10% of 2016 – 17 MSc Management of Information Systems & Digital Innovation graduates did not respond to the survey.

Based on the data collected, the majority of the graduates are employed overseas at present, with the majority starting their current job three to six months after graduation. The start date is dependent on their offer, as larger companies showed a trend of an extended wait time prior to on-boarding.



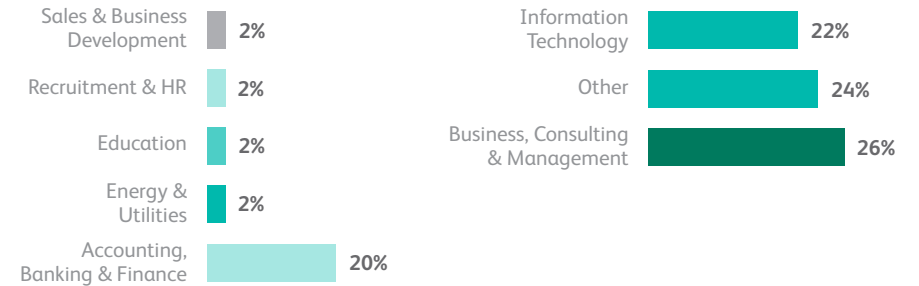
Where do our graduates work?

Most MSc Management of Information Systems & Digital Innovation graduates have been employed in their home country. Graduates of this course tend to work in cities containing more high-tech development enterprises, compared with other courses' graduates.

We also host Recruiter events on campus, as well as on site company visits and online interactions.



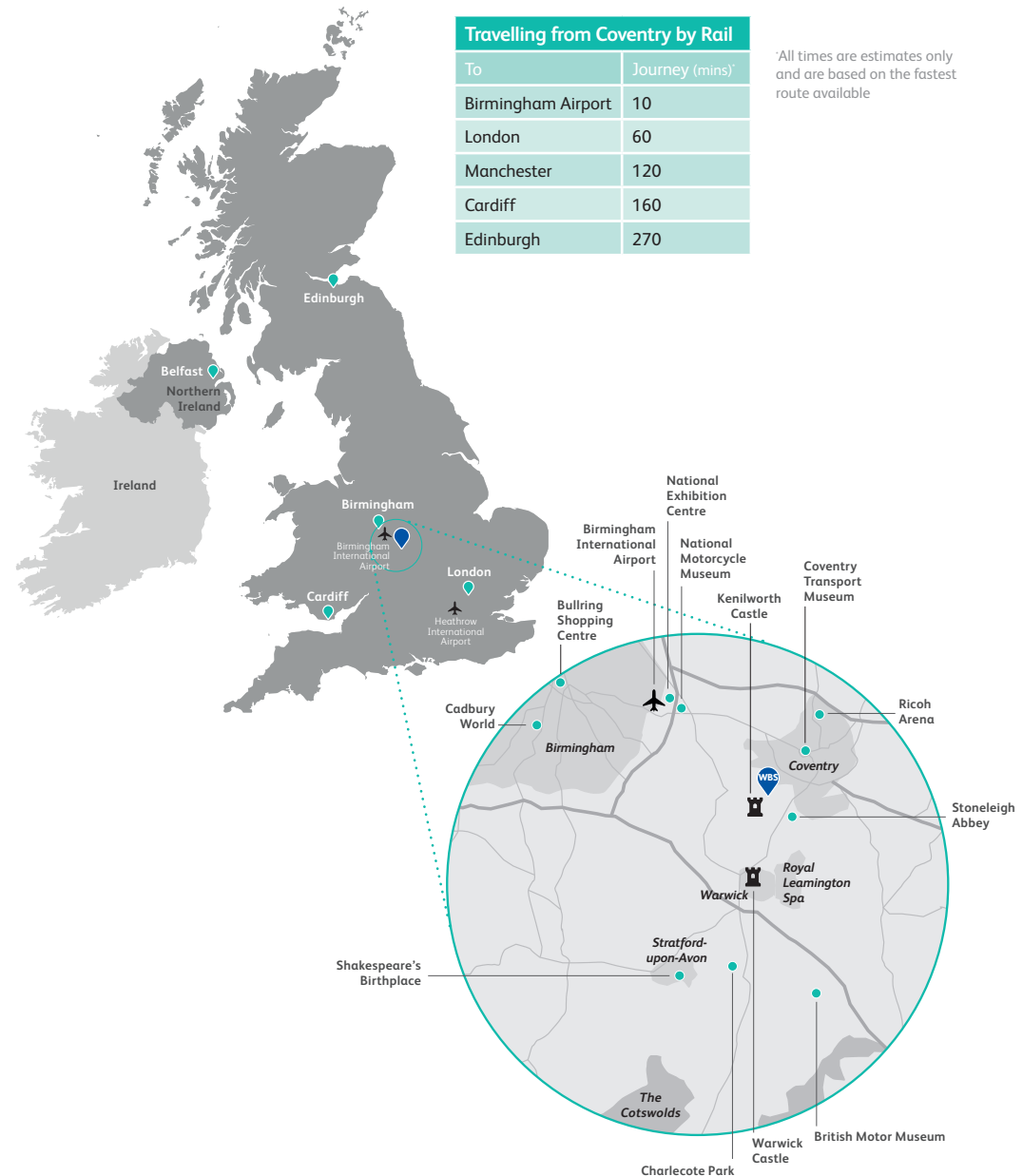
Our location
