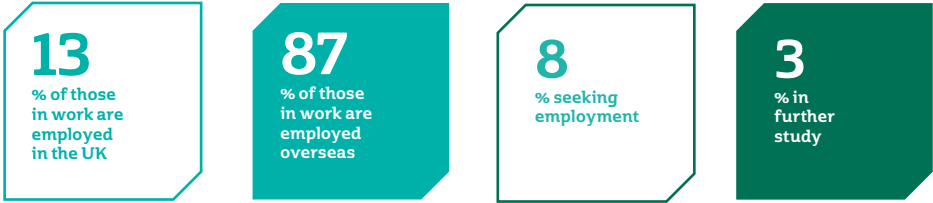

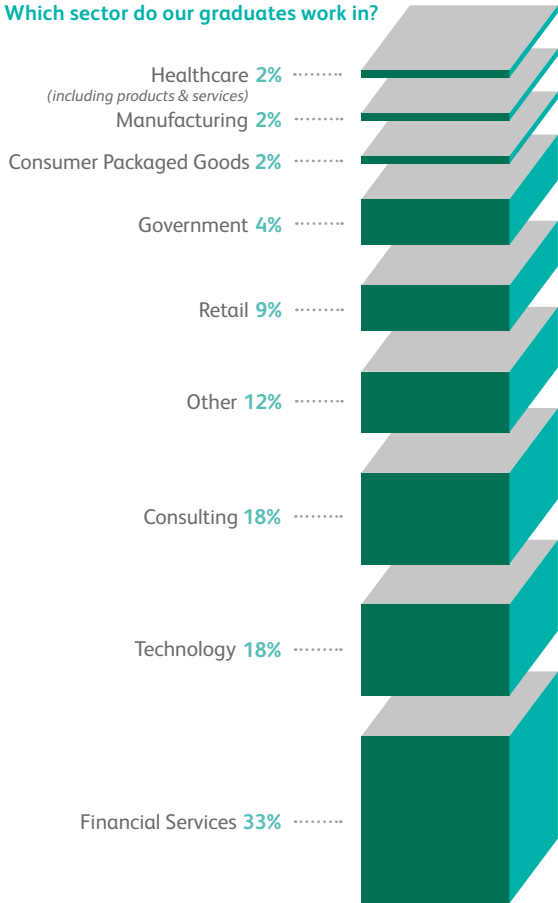

89% of graduates are in full-time employment six months after graduation.

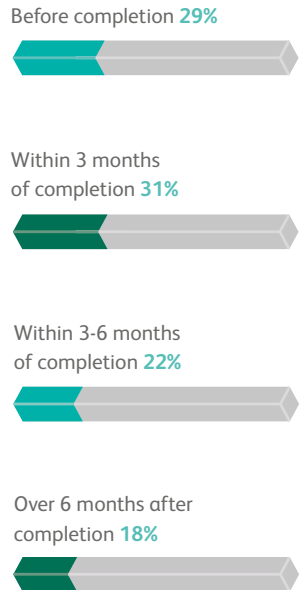


A total of 76 of a possible 114 graduates were surveyed, and an aggregate response rate of 67% was achieved.

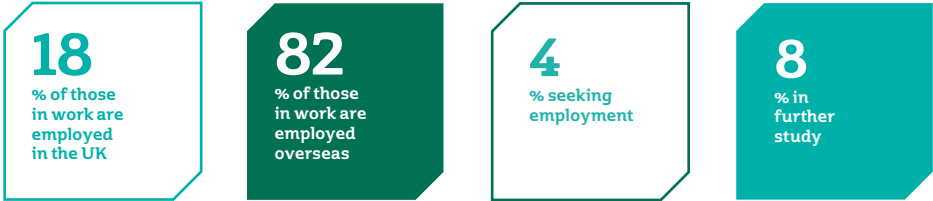

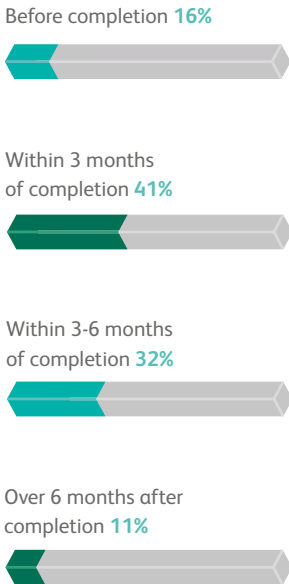

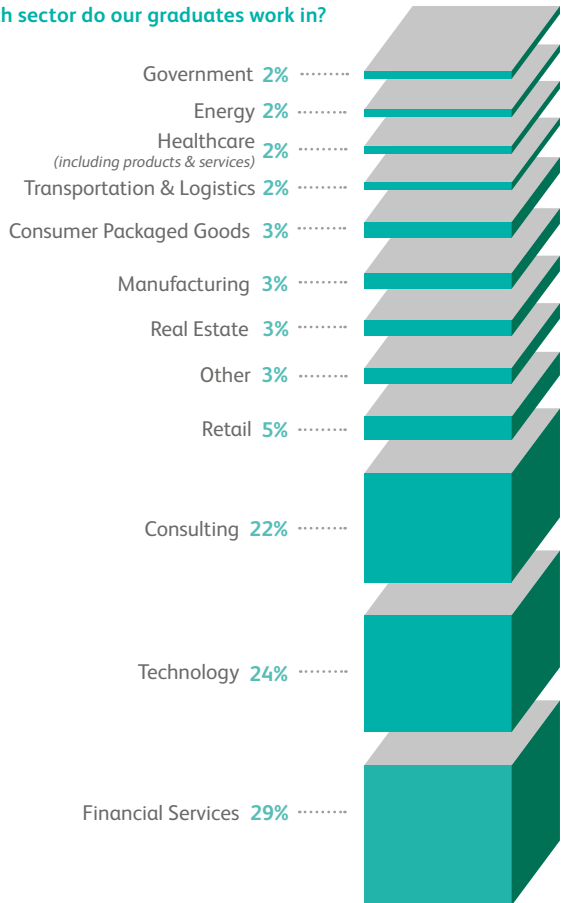


A total of 71 of a possible 101 graduates were surveyed, and an aggregate response rate of 70% was achieved.

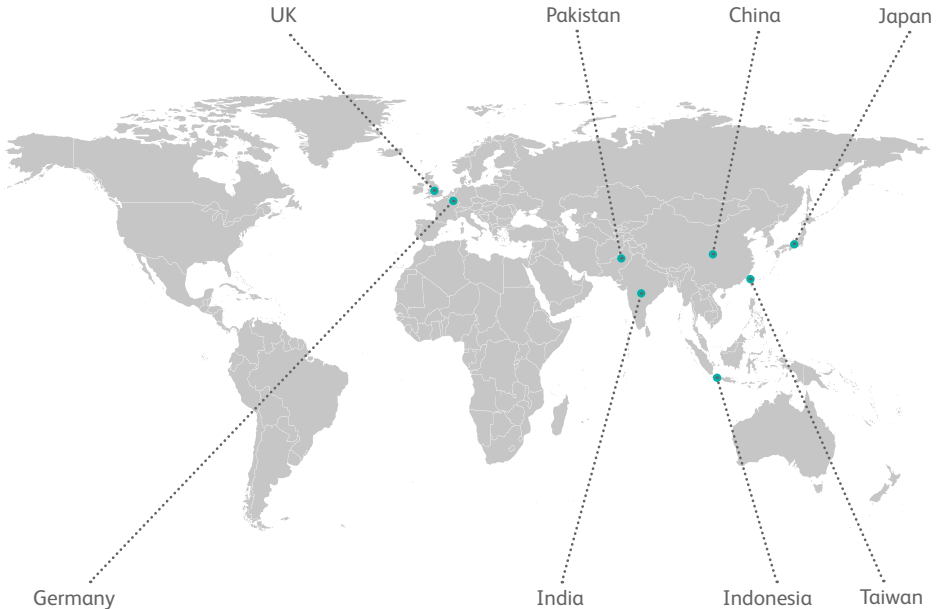

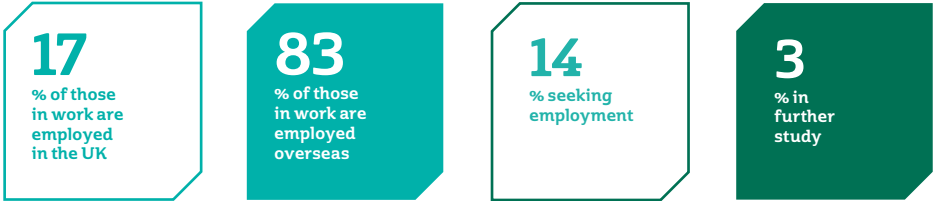

Which countries do our graduates go on to work in?



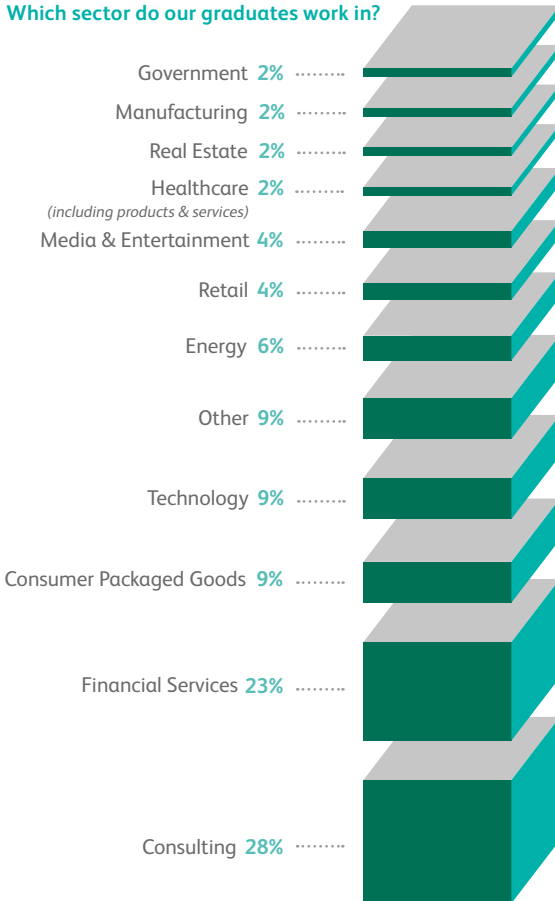

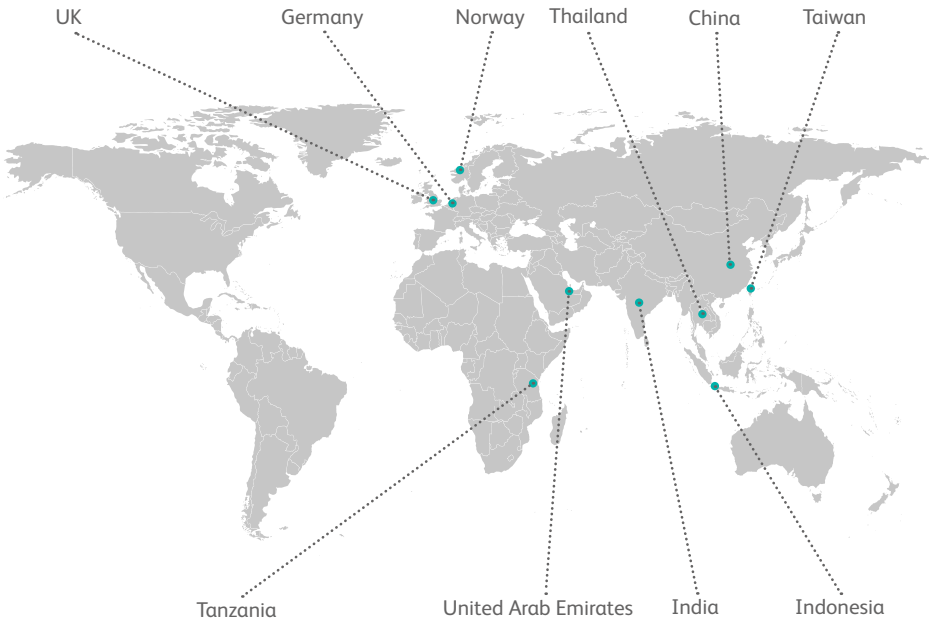

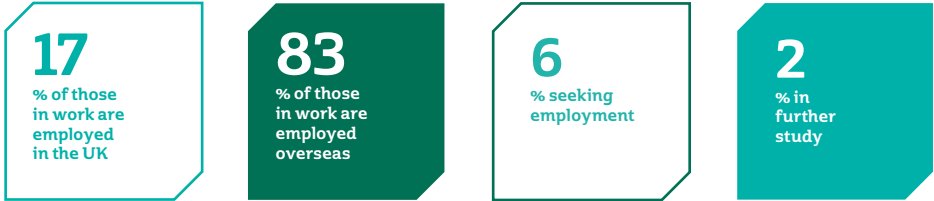

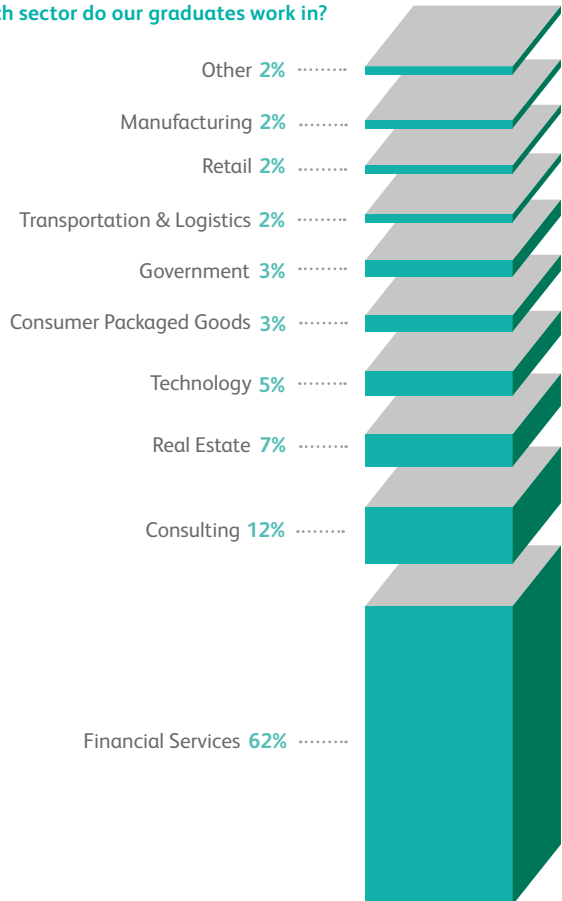

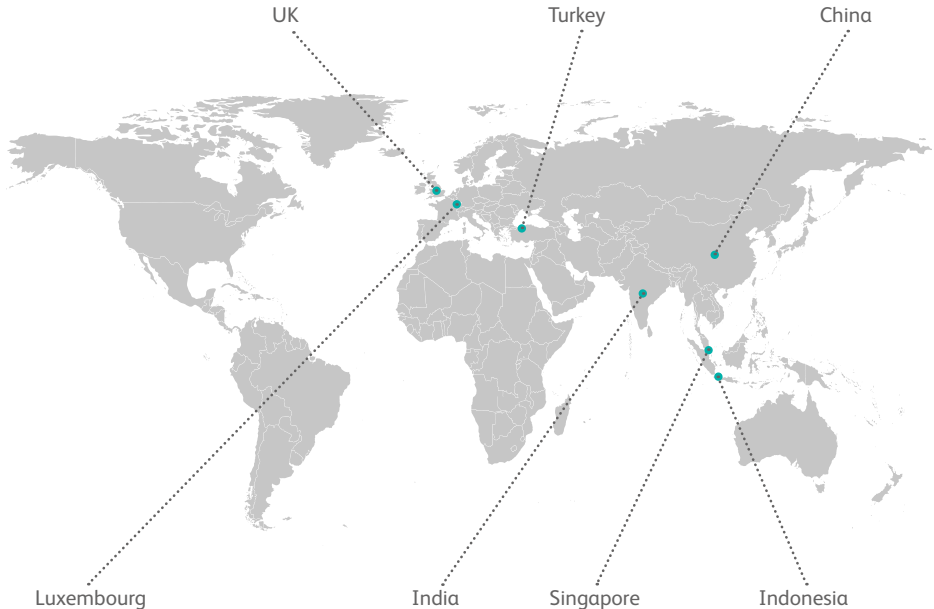

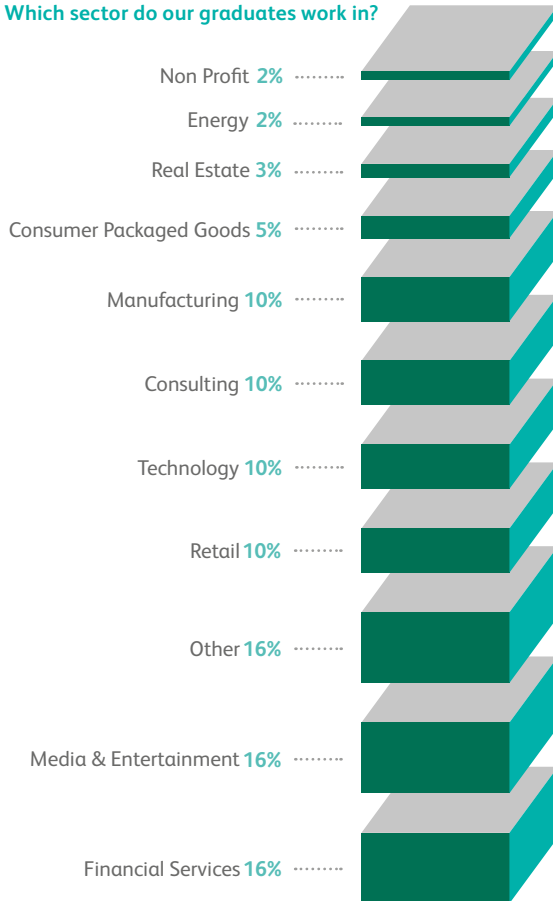

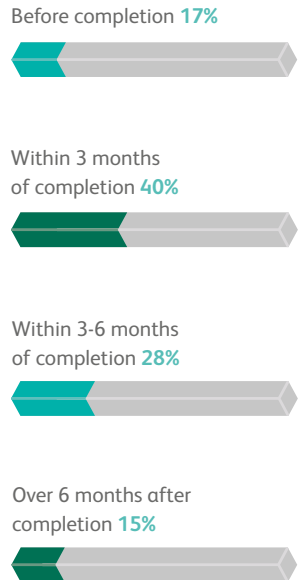
