Course structure

Global Central Banking and Financial Regulation Qualification

A part-time, online programme delivered in partnership with the Bank of England and built with finance industry professionals in mind. This specialised programme has been designed to introduce you to the latest evidence led and practice informed financial regulation and monetary policy.

Build your expertise

To help build your expertise in a way that suits you we offer a range of different qualification options as part of the MSc Global Central Banking and Financial Regulation. This means that if you are unable to commit to the full MSc, you can still develop your skills and knowledge with the following options:

- Successfully complete any individual module and receive a **Postgraduate Award**
- Successfully complete any three modules and receive a **Postgraduate Certificate**
- Successfully complete any six modules (excluding the Research Methods & Dissertation module) to receive a **Postgraduate Diploma**
- Successfully complete any six modules and the Research Methods & Dissertation module to be awarded the full **MSc**

Successful completion of a single module grants the participant a Postgraduate Award. You can take one of these as an individual award before deciding to upgrade to a higher award.

An individual module (excluding the Research Methods & Dissertation module) is studied in 17 weeks and is expected to equate to roughly 200 hours of student effort, including the time taken to complete the assessment(s).

Please note that you may only complete one module at a time.

Credit gained from successful completion of an individual module is valid for a period of five years.

Each module consists of a mixture of interactive webinars, pre-recorded online lectures, case studies including Bank of England case studies, and set texts.

When are modules running?

Individual modules are available at a set time across a three session yearly structure. For 2019/20, three out of the seven modules will be available. For 2020/21, seven modules will be available for selection. The Research Methods & Dissertation module will be available 2021/22. You may choose to start in either October, February or June each year.

Please be aware that the *Research Methods & Dissertation* module has one set start date each year, 2021/22.
